Dear Parents/Carers

There is growing concern over the number of students breaking our uniform regulations. This letter is to remind you of your agreement to support us in maintaining high standards and fairness.

We feel it is necessary to apply the after-school detention sanction for persistent disobedience.

A number of years ago our Governors agreed that black trousers could be introduced as an option for girls. They have stipulated that only suitable "uniform style" trousers are allowed. These may be obtained from J.R. Swifts our Uniform Suppliers, as well as other uniform suppliers.

"Fashion style" trousers are not allowed, e.g. hipsters, combats, stretch fabrics or styles with buckles or tags. Trousers must be worn on the waist, if necessary supported by a plain black belt.

Governors, Staff and Parents want the uniform to be neat, smart and distinctive of the identity of Saint Martin's. Your assistance is required to ensure that money is not wasted by making the "fashion" choice. Students are not allowed to wear unsuitable items.

Students will be allowed to wear their optional Summer uniform, i.e. polo shirt **and** sweatshirt, when they return to school after the Easter break on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> May.
